
Simple Tab Groups

- Declutter your browser tab bar
- My Web browsing with Firefox
 - Long term Firefox user, still use other browsers
 - I had too many tabs open & it was taking too long to find websites I had open on the tab bar.
 - I wasn't using the Firefox Bookmark Manager except for a few bookmarks saved to the Bookmark Toolbar.
 - I needed to get more organised
 - Started searched the web for a better Bookmark Manager
 - While searching I heard about grouping tabs so then started searching for those.
 - Viewed a YouTube video on "Simple Tab Groups"
 - I was impressed and thought I'd give STG a try.
 - I also looked at how other browsers were implementing tab groupings
 - Installed STG about 3-4 months ago and haven't looked back


What is Simple Tab Groups?




- Simple Tab Groups is an add-on for Firefox that creates & modifies tab groups
- Simple Tab Groups is an easy way to declutter your browser and organize your tabs
- STG is easy to use and very convenient
- STG closes tabs rather than hides them like similar programs.
- Has become my default Bookmark manager. Although I still use the Bookmark Toolbar.
- With STG I'm now much more organised than I was previously
- Firefox has not yet implemented tab groupings.
- Other Chromium based browsers are beginning to incorporate tab
 groupings as a feature within their browsers. Time permitting I hope
 to show those. In my opinion none are as good as STGs.




- So far:
 - I've described Simple Tab Groups and why I needed it

- However most users like me will have a large number of tabs already open which they wish to keep
- The process for us is slightly different to that shown in the video.
- Step 1 Write down a list of topic names for your Tab Groups.
 e.g. MelbPC, Holidays, Technology, Photography, Software, Home,
 Android, Music, Video, Health, Office procedures etc.
 More tabs can be added along the way.

Using Simple Tab Groups - Continued




 The next step is to create your first Tab Group by clicking the STG toolbar icon and select "create new group"



- The first group created will include all open tabs. This group doesn't have a name.
- Create groups for each of the topics listed earlier
- Drag each tab into the appropriate group using Manage Groups icon
- Demonstration: Existing Firefox user with multiple tabs already open.










Hover mouse pointer over the STG icon to show currently displayed Tab Group








Group settings menu options:

- Rename a group
- Change a groups icon style & colour shown on the Firefox tab bar.
- Mute tabs when a group is closed/restored
- Make a sticky group (tabs that are never moved from the group)
- Show/discard tabs after moving
- Simple Tab Groups works with Firefox Containers, and can be configured to automatically move specific containers to a particular group. For e.g. If you have a container for shopping websites, and you have created a Tab Group called shopping, it may be a good idea to move the tabs in the Shopping container to the group.



Negatives



- Initial sorting of tabs into groups is time consuming
- Opening internet links from an email, newsletter, other website etc opens tab in the current tab group. The new tab then needs to be dragged to the collect group.
- STG does not load instantaneously & takes a short time to load when Firefox is first started
- A tab may belong to two or more groups making searching for it later more difficult.
- Too many tabs open, easy to get lazy again.




Right mouse click on the Workspace icon for options menu.


