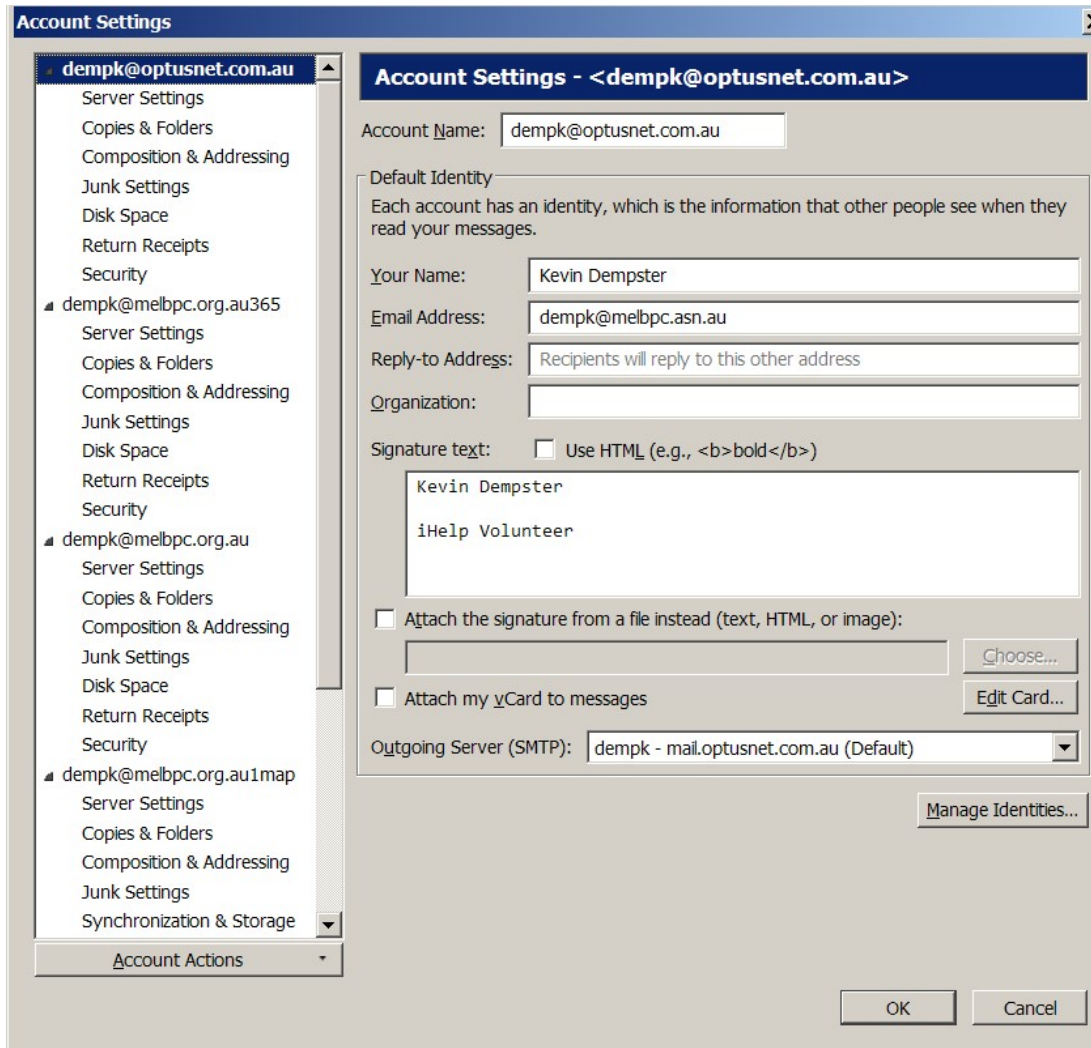




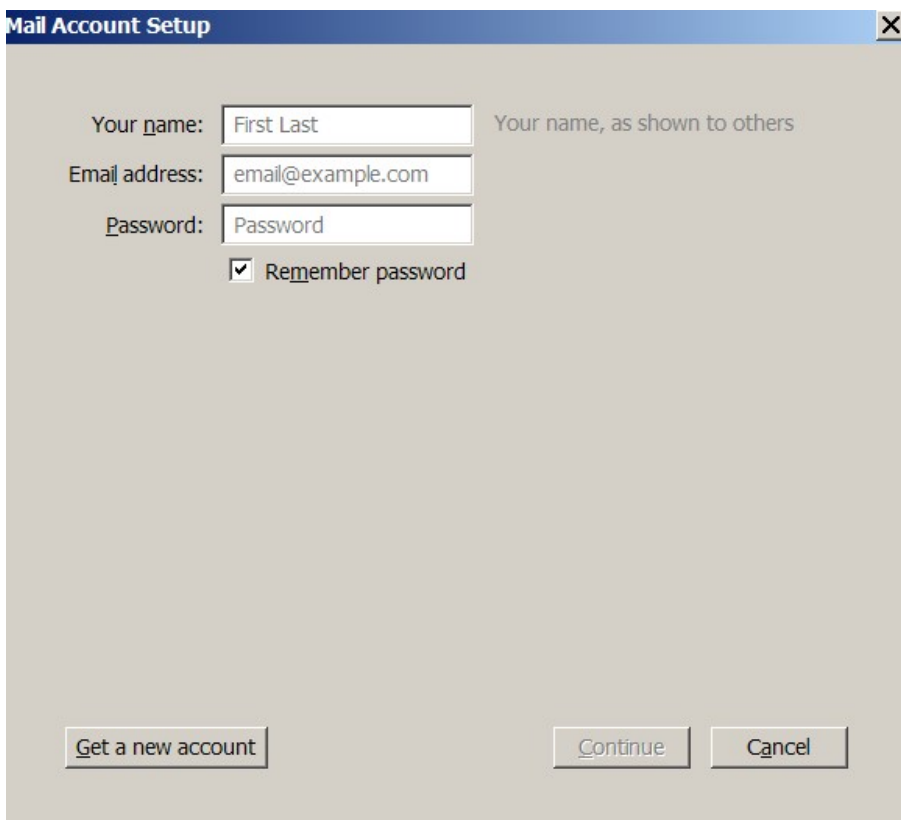
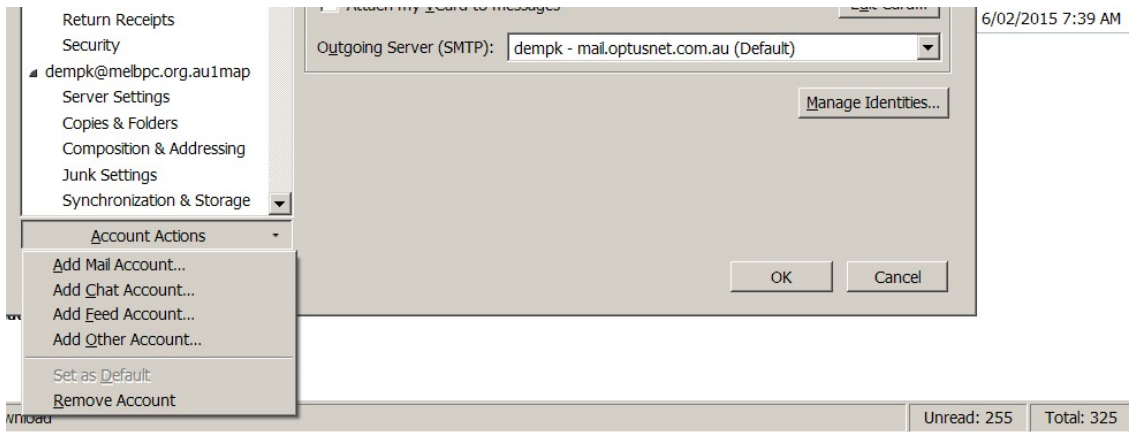
Thunderbird Pop Setup

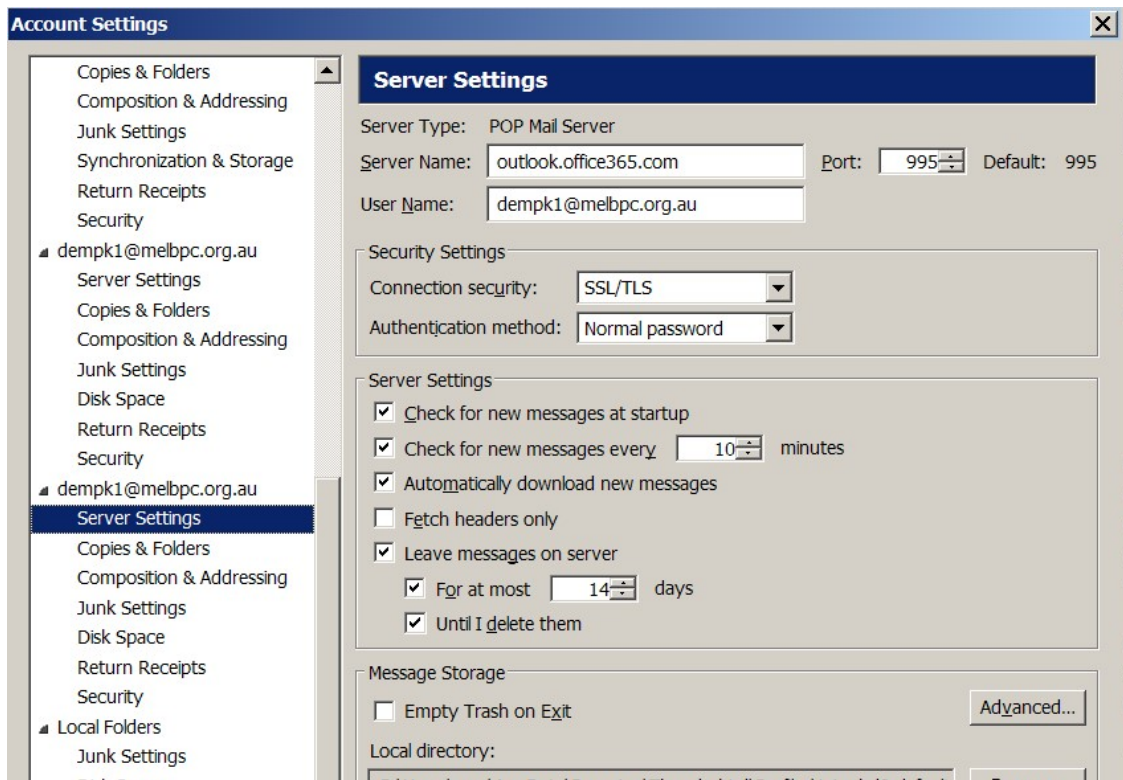
Buttons at the bottom: Get a new account, Advanced config, Re-test, Done, Cancel.
